

Water, Water Everywhere!

(Pre-k – rising 8th graders; campers grouped according to age)

- Session 1 - June 7 – 11;
- Session 6A - August 9 – 13

This camp is centered around water and we are going to have fun with it! This camp will focus primarily on science experiments and art projects that revolve around the water theme. Best of all, though, there will be outside water play DAILY, where campers can splash, squirt, slide, and cool down on the beautiful campus of The Magnolia School.

All the World's a Stage

(Rising Pre-k – rising 11th graders; campers grouped according to age)

- Session 2 – June 14 - 25

Our theatre camp combines improvisation, acting, directing and scene study along with two theatrical performances which will be presented on Thursday evening of the second week. This is a camp for novices and experienced actors. Everyone will also be given an opportunity to learn about set design and construction, make-up and costuming.

Around the World in 10 Days

(Pre-k – rising 8th graders; campers grouped according to age)

- Session 3 - June 28 – July 9

Grab your passport and see the world - in just 10 days! In this camp, we'll have a lot of fun by engaging in hands-on activities that teach about different parts of the world. We'll explore the culture, food, art, language, music and dance of far-away places from all around the globe.

Eco-Challenge Camp

(Pre-k – rising 8th graders; campers grouped according to age)

- Session 4 - July 12 – 23

The Magnolia School provides the perfect environment to connect with the outdoors and learn some cool new survival skills. We'll try primitive cooking, discover how to read maps and compasses, learn about making fires and shelter, and explore bugs. Campers will explore the wonders of nature and gain the skills to encourage sound decision-making in their ecological environment.

GREENart

(Pre-k – rising 8th graders; campers grouped according to age)

- Session 5 - July 26 – August 6

We'll take discarded materials and turn them into the coolest (and GREENest!) art around. Campers will learn how to take abandoned and found items and turn them into jewelry, sculptures, prints, mosaics and other extraordinary pieces of art.

Junior Exploring the Great Outdoors

(Rising 4th graders – Rising 7th graders)

- Session 6B – August 9 - 13

This camp is very similar to the Exploring the Great Outdoors camp offered earlier in the summer, but will be tailored specifically for campers in their late elementary/early middle school years. Our outdoor adventures will include canoeing, kayaking, swimming and hiking. Experienced outdoor leaders and lifeguards will guide our explorations.
